Dear Parents and Carers,

The children have been learning about the work done by UNICEF and as a school we are working towards gaining the Rights Respecting Schools certification. In 1989, governments across the world promised all children the same rights by adopting the UN Convention on the Rights of the child. The Convention says what countries must do so that all children grow as healthy as possible, can learn at school, are protected, have their views listened to, and are treated fairly. Each class has created a class charter based on the rights. They have considered what it means to them and created rules and responsibilities to match each right. Every year group has chosen a different theme to display their rights within the classroom- from Harry Potter to The Gruffalo. Year four visited the British Museum on Thursday to enhance their learning of the Egyptians.
