Dear Parents and Carers,

Within the last couple of weeks some children in Year 6 have started their Buddy positions at lunchtimes. The children have a range of responsibilities that are all linked to supporting children across the school. It is wonderful to see the Year 6 children setting the standard for all children to follow.

Thank you to the parents who attended the Rights Respecting School coffee afternoon on Monday. It was a great opportunity for parents to learn more about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), which is a legally-binding international agreement setting out the civil, political, economic, social and cultural rights of every child, regardless of their race, religion or abilities. This week the children have been introduced to the playground charter that was discussed and created by the school council using ideas from their peers. This charter links directly to these Rights of the Child and is also in-line with our School Values of Excellence, Enjoyment, Courage, Partnership, Trust and Equality.

Our Parent Consultation evening last night gave all parents of children within YR1-6 the opportunity to meet with their class teacher to discuss the progress, attainment and next steps for their child. Your support at home with your child's learning helps to consolidate your child's understanding of topics covered within school and deepen their understanding.
