School Games Mark Award 2015-16

In September, we applied for the School Games Mark for our achievements in the last academic year, and we were successful in achieving the gold award. We have now been presented with our plaque to display proudly in our trophy cabinet. We hope that this year is as successful, and we would like to thank parents in advance for all of their support for this academic year.

KS1 Sportshall Athletics

KS1 - Two excited teams participate in the KS1 Sportshall Athletics competition. All of the children performed brilliantly, with the YR2 team finishing 7th and the YR1 team finishing 23rd. Good potential for the coming years.

YR5 & 6 Athletics

13 boys and 13 girls from YR5 and 6 took part in the borough competition held at Peter May. Overall, our boys finished 1st with 347 points and the girls finished 5th with 299 points. Our combined time score of 646 point means Larkswood emerged as the borough champions, and we will now go onto the next round against the representatives from Haringey, Enfield, Hackney, Islington, Camden, City of London, Southwark and Westminster.

This event will take place at the Copper Box on Wednesday 22 February 2017, with the top two schools going forward to the London final at Crystal Palace. Come on Larkswood!

YR3 & 4 First Step Netball

A team from YR3 and a team from YR4 represented Larkswood at their first ever First Step Netball event. It was a highly competitive contest, and the children performed valiantly.
