QuadKids – Feel Good Games

Again, defending our Borough crown, Larkwood entered this year's QuadKids competition, having trained hard for many weeks!

QuadKids is a child's version of the women's heptathlon and the men's decathlon - each child has to complete a sprint (50m for year 3&4 and 75m for year 5&6), a long distance race (400m for year 3&4 and 600m for year 5&6), throw a vortex howler and a standing long jump.

With the indoor athletics (Sportshall Athletics) already won, this competition was approached with a high level of confidence. The children from year 3, 4, 5 and 6 all performed brilliant, with many completing personal bests in all of the different disciplines.
